HQ IMCOM has recently developed a five day version of the training course tailored for army garrison bridge managers and inspectors at OCONUS garrisons.

Training concentrates on:

- 1) Duties and responsibilities of a garrison bridge manager,
- 2) Identifying, evaluating, and documenting the various bridge components and deficiencies,
- 3) Bridge design characteristics and inspection methods for common concrete, steel, and timber structures,
- 4) Identifying and evaluating various culverts and waterway deficiencies,
- 5) Determining bridge Installation Status Report, and
- 6) Requirements for civilian load capacity and Military Load Classification.

This course replaces IMCOM Academy Course PW 126 for OCONUS DPW staff.

Army policy requires every garrison /installation that has bridges, have a Bridge Manager appointed by the Garrison Commander. The garrison/installation Bridge Manager must complete an approved comprehensive bridge inspection training course followed by an approved refresher every 5 years.

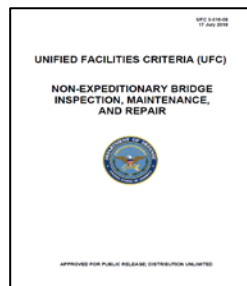


Training Schedule
