Note that updating these .xml files requires administrator rights

- 1. Exit PCASE.
- 2. Go to C:/ProgramData/PCASE
 - a. If you don't see the Program Data folder, select the view tab "View" tab in Windows Explorer and check the "Hidden items" box.

- 3. Go to <u>https://transportation.erdc.dren.mil/pcase/software.aspx</u> and download the .xml file you wish to update (Vehicles, Traffic (standard traffic patterns), Weather (climate data), or Drainage (precipitation data).
- 4. save the new .xml file from the site to C:/ProgramData/PCASE.
- 5. Once you open PCASE, the new database(s) will be available

Note: this procedure will not affect any custom vehicles you may have. These are stored at <User Data Directory>\Shared\System\PCASE\Custom Vehicles. You can determine your User Data Directory by selecting Help>>Program Version in PCASE and then selecting the Open user data folder button.
